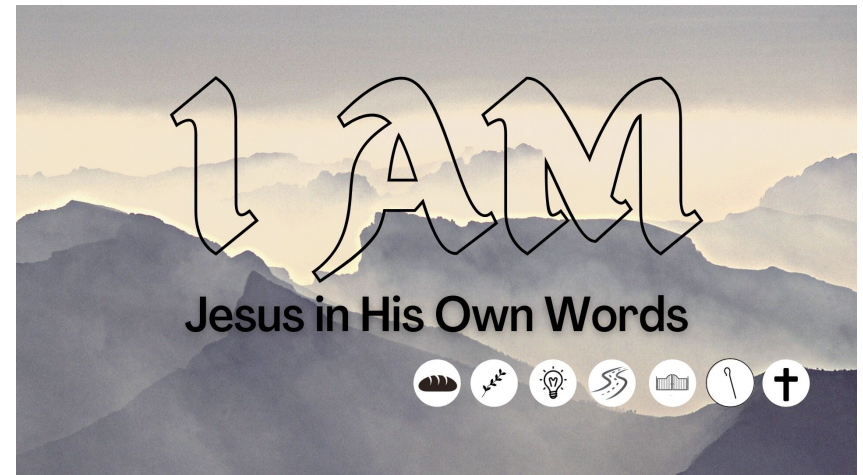

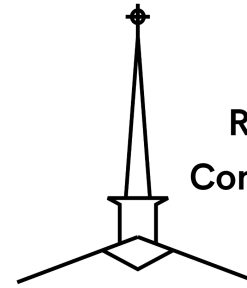

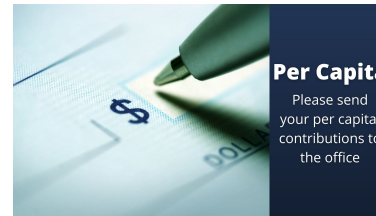


Congregational Meeting
